

Resolution 2010-2. On Establishing the Edward Kidder Graham Faculty Service Award.

The Faculty Council resolves:

The Edward Kidder Graham Faculty Service Award is hereby established to recognize outstanding service by a member of the Voting Faculty of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The award calls to remembrance President Graham's ambition to "to make the campus co-extensive with the boundaries of the State," in the context of the University's modern mission to extend knowledge-based service world-wide.

Eligibility and general guidelines for the Award are:

1. The recipient is recommended by the Committee on Honorary Degrees and Special Awards upon nomination of any member of the General Faculty. The committee's recommendation is approved by the Faculty Council.
2. The recipient is a member of the Voting Faculty at the time the award is conferred.
3. The recipient exemplifies the University's mission of service to the State of North Carolina, the nation, and the world.
4. The award is presented at the annual University Day Convocation or some other appropriate occasion.
5. The award is evidenced by a certificate and medal.
6. The identity of the recipient is not published until the award is presented.
7. The award lapses if the recipient does not appear at the stated occasion at which it is to be conferred.
