Resolution 1998-8. Endorsing the Offering of Courses as a Staff Benefit.

Presented by the Educational Policy Committee.

The Faculty Council resolves:

Section 1. That the University offer courses as a staff benefit, and that the University faculty and administration encourage the enrollment of staff in scheduled University courses.

Sec. 2. That supervisors adjust work schedules to allow staff to attend University courses. This may entail the use of flex-time options to allow staff to attend University courses while continuing to meet their normal employment obligations.
